Northern Rockies

Day 1 - September 18, 2024: Your adventure begins with anticipation as a Globe Treks Representative greets you at your doorstep, whisking you away to the Charlotte airport for a flight to Rapid City, SD. Upon arrival, the magic unfolds as you embark on a scenic drive through Spearfish Canyon, a natural wonder carved by time and water. Day 3 - September 20: Embrace the morning serenity with a visit to Mount Rushmore National Memorial, where the faces of great leaders etched into the mountainside echo tales of history. Delight in a leisurely lunch at the Crazy Horse Memorial, a tribute to the indomitable spirit of Native Americans. As the day unfolds, return to the charming Sylvan Lake Lodge. Here, you have the option to embark on a scenic one mile walk around Sylvan Lake, the changing foliage whispering tales of the changing seasons, before indulging in a delicious dinner, where the flavors are as vibrant as the surroundings.

Day 4 - September 21: Embark on a picturesque journey through Wyoming, a land of wide- open spaces and endless horizons. Marvel at the grandeur of the Tetons as you pass through the town of Jackson, where nature's majesty knows no bounds. Unpack your bags and settle into the magical Jackson Lake Lodge, a sanctuary nestled between mountains and water, offering unparalleled views of pristine wilderness—a true bucket-list experience.

Day 5 - September 22: Today, the Tetons unveil their secrets. Ascend to the top of the Tetons via tram, where the world below appears as a canvas of natural wonders. Then, surrender to the gentle rhythm of the Snake River on a scenic raft trip, allowing the splendor of the Tetons to reflect in its waters, creating a symphony of nature's artistry.

Day 6 - September 23: Bid a fond farewell to the Tetons and embark on a captivating journey along Rockefeller Parkway, a corridor connecting two iconic national parks. Enter Yellowstone National Park, the nation's first, founded in 1872, where wildlife roams freely and geothermal wonders abound. Explore the Fountain Paint Pots, where vibrant colors dance in harmony with bubbling mud, and visit the Midway Geyser Basin, a surreal landscape of steam and vibrant hues. Witness the grandeur of Grand Prismatic Spring, a natural marvel painted with vivid shades.
