Captivating Canyonlands: **Day by Day**

Day 1: Departure & Las Vegas Welcome

Enjoy a smooth pick-up at your doorstep and a light continental breakfast en route to the airport. Upon arrival, you will meet your custom outfitted Globe Treks Motorcoach and driver. Relax as you transfer to your elegant hotel. This evening, meet your fellow travelers for a festive reception and welcome dinner. Savor a gourmet meal, raise a glass to the journey ahead, and settle in for a restful night beneath the glittering lights of the desert.

Day 2: Red Rock Canyon & Zion National Park

After breakfast, we travel west to Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area, where towering crimson cliffs and sandstone formations tell the story of a landscape shaped over 180 million years. A short scenic walk reveals vibrant desert flora and overlooks. Continuing north through St. George, Utah, we pause at the delightful Red Hills Desert Garden—Utah’s first interactive desert garden, featuring native plants, endangered species, and fossilized dinosaur tracks. By afternoon, we arrive at Zion National Park and check in to the historic Zion Lodge, nestled in the heart of the canyon. Enjoy dinner at the lodge restaurant, then take a peaceful evening stroll as the sun sets and the sandstone cliffs glow in soft pinks and golds.

Day 3: Zion National Park – A Sanctuary of Natural Grandeur

Your day begins with a private tram ride and guided tour through Zion’s landmarks—Checkerboard Mesa, the Great Arch, and the dramatic Narrows, where vertical walls rise nearly 2,000 feet. Along the way, your guide will bring to life the park’s rich geology and unique wildlife. After a picnic lunch, the afternoon is yours—perhaps join your tour manager for a gentle hike or simply relax on the veranda, taking in Zion’s majestic scenery.

Day 4: Bryce Canyon National Park – A Sculpted Fantasyland

Journey northeast to Bryce Canyon National Park, where whimsical hoodoos—otherworldly spires carved by wind and water—create a breathtaking landscape. With a naturalist guide, explore the Amphitheater and stunning overlooks such as Inspiration Point and Sunset Point. After a picnic lunch, settle in at the charming Bryce Canyon Lodge. This evening, enjoy a delicious dinner followed by a short walk to the canyon’s edge to watch the sun sink below a forest of hoodoos.

Day 5: Capitol Reef National Park & Arrival in Moab

Rise early to greet the sunrise over Bryce before traveling through the dramatic landscapes on the edge of Grand Staircase–Escalante National Monument. Arrive in Capitol Reef National Park, a hidden gem defined by massive sandstone domes, narrow canyons, and cliffs that once formed a “reef” impassable to early pioneers. In Green River, stop at the John Wesley Powell River History Museum to learn about the daring 19th-century expedition that first charted the Colorado River through the Grand Canyon. By evening, arrive in Moab, Utah and check in to the beautiful Red Cliffs Lodge, perched on the banks of the Colorado River. Enjoy a hearty dinner followed by stargazing beneath Moab’s famously dark skies.

Day 6: Canyonlands & Dead Horse Point

This morning’s adventure takes you into Canyonlands National Park, where the Colorado and Green Rivers converge in a maze of canyons, mesas, and spires. A private guide will reveal the park’s dramatic vistas and deep geologic history during your visit. After a picnic lunch, continue to Dead Horse Point State Park, where the sweeping view of the river-carved canyon below is among the most breathtaking in the West. Tonight, enjoy an old-fashioned cowboy cookout followed by a tranquil sunset river cruise.

Day 7: Arches National Park & Rocky Mountaineer

Explore Arches National Park this morning with your private guide. Walk among graceful stone arches and towers that defy gravity, including the world-famous Delicate Arch. Learn about the park’s unique geology and ancient cultural history before enjoying free time in Moab for lunch and shopping. In the afternoon, board the luxurious Canyon Spirit by Rocky Mountaineer for your rail journey to Glenwood Springs, Colorado where we will have a comfortable overnight stay. Indulge in gourmet meals, signature cocktails, a private club car, and sweeping views through oversized glass windows.

Day 8: Glenwood Springs to Denver – Rail Through the Rockies

Wake up at your hotel to fresh mountain air and then board the Canyon Spirit by Rocky Mountaineer, climbing through the magnificent Rocky Mountains. See wildlife, pass roaring rivers, alpine meadows, and the Continental Divide before descending into the front range. Arrive in Denver and celebrate with a farewell dinner near the airport.

Day 9: Return Home

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight home to Charlotte, where a Globe Treks representative will ensure a smooth return.

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
