Burgundy Region Private Barge Cruise Day by Day

Paris pre-cruise option: 10/17/25 - 10/21/25. Fly on 10/17 & arrive 10/18 - see below for pre-cruise details

Day 1, Oct 20: Cruise-only guests fly to Paris

Day 2, Oct 21: Hotel pre-night in Paris. Connect with Paris pre-cruise guests.

Day 3, Oct 22: Travel by high-speed train from Paris to Dijon. Embark barge at 6:00 p.m. Settle into cabins, then we'll introduce the crew at a welcome cocktail before dinner.

Day 4, Oct 23 - DIJON:

Join us on an excursion along the Grands Crus wine route, which passes through the most prestigious of the Burgundy vineyards, including a wine-tasting session. We'll return onboard and cruise to Petit-Ouges, discovering the lush landscape of the Saône Valley. Upon arrival in Petit-Ouges, discover the "Path of the Three Wash Houses."

Day 5, Oct 24 DIJON-PETIT-OUGES: The whole day will be spent cruising towards Saint-Jean-de-Losne. Take the time to sit back and admire the scenery as we cruise. We'll arrive in Saint-Jean-de-Losne late in the afternoon.

Day 6, Oct 25 PETIT-OUGES - SAINT-JOHN-DE-LOSNE: Join us on a visit of Saint-Jean-de-Losne, the capital of canal barging in France, which lies at the heart of the French waterways and canal system in southern Burgundy. The afternoon will be spent cruising towards Dole.

Day 7, Oct 26 SAINT-JOHN-DE-LOSNE - DOLE: Enjoy a unique tour, following the "trail of the Chat Perché". This trail refers to the famous tales of a Perched Cat, written by Marcel Aymé who lived in Dole (a beautiful hillside) as a child. We'll then cruise towards Ranchot. You may use the onboard bicycles to ride on the bike path following our route.

Day 8, Oct 27 DOLE - RANCHOT: In the morning, we will cruise. In the afternoon, we'll set out by coach to Arc-et-Senans for a tour of the Saline Royale. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this royal factory, built between 1775 and 1779 in the shape of a semi-circle, was where salt workers traditionally lived and worked. Tonight is our special gala evening.

Day 9, Oct 28 - RANCHOT - BESANCON: Enjoy one last buffet breakfast on board before disembarking at 9:00 a.m. Transfer from Besancon to Geneva airport for our flights home.
