

America's Canyonlands

Day 1 thru 3 March 9 - 11 Riders At home pick up and departure from Hendersonville. Overnight in Memphis, TN, Oklahoma City, OK and last night in Albuquerque, NM.

Day 4 March 12 Meet our flyers and drive all together to Cortez, CO and overnight.

Day 5 March 13 Morning tour of Mesa Verde National Park where the ancestral Pueblo people lived for over 700 years. Today, the park protects over 4,000 known archeological sites including 600 cliff dwellings. After our picnic lunch, we will take the scenic drive to Moab, UT with a stop at Wilson



Arch. Enjoy the views of Canyonlands NP and the Colorado River. Overnight two evenings at the Red Cliffs Lodge on the banks of the Colorado outside of Moab. This is one of our most favorite resorts!

We'll enjoy a wonderful cowboy cookout overlooking the river.

Day 6 March 14 This morning we will enjoy a guided tour of Arches National Park. You will be amazed by the red-hued landscape of this park which boasts more than 2000 natural sandstone arches and numerous towers and balancing rocks. After lunch at the Moab Brewery, we will take a fun boat tour on the Colorado & see Canyonlands NP from the water. We'll cruise through Horseshoe Bend and marvel at the towering red rock walls, and view ancient pictographs on the way back to Red Cliffs.



Day 7 March 15 Morning drive to Goblin Valley State Park and view the alien landscape of balancing boulders and sculpted spires. We will head westward and drive through the farm valleys near Capitol Reef National Park and marvel at the sheer formations amid gorgeous forest scenery. We will overnight at the Capitol Reef Best Western.

Day 8 March 16 Today we have the great joy of

seeing the spires and viewing points of spectacular Bryce Canyon NP. We will overnight in Bryce Canyon so that we can fully enjoy the scenery.



Day 9 March 17 Today we will take an incredibly thrilling and almost magical drive down into the wide Zion Valley. This is one of America's best drives. We have two nights just outside the Park in lovely Springdale, UT.

Day 10 March 18 Today you are free to explore Zion on your own or with friends. The Park Service runs an amazingly comprehensive shuttle service from the impressive visitor's center. Hop aboard and go see any or all of the park you like! Your tour manager will be on hand as well.

Day 11 March 19 We will depart from Zion and head south and make a clockwise route along the edge of the massive Grand Canyon. We will enter at the east end and see the Desert Watchtower and Grand View Point on our way to Tusayan and our hotel at the South Rim.

Day 12 March 20 We will take a tour of the South Rim and have plenty of time to explore the Canyon Village scene. Make time for a short walk to the historic Kolb Photographic Studio and check out the exhibits there.



Day 13 March 21 Drive to Albuquerque and enjoy a farewell fiesta in Old Town prior to our overnight in town.

Day 14 March 22 We will take our flyers to the airport this morning. Riders begin our drive home with an overnight stop in Oklahoma City.

Day 15 March 23 Drive & overnight in Memphis.

Day 16 March 24 Drive & return home to Hendersonville where the Globe Treks staff will take you right back to your door step.
