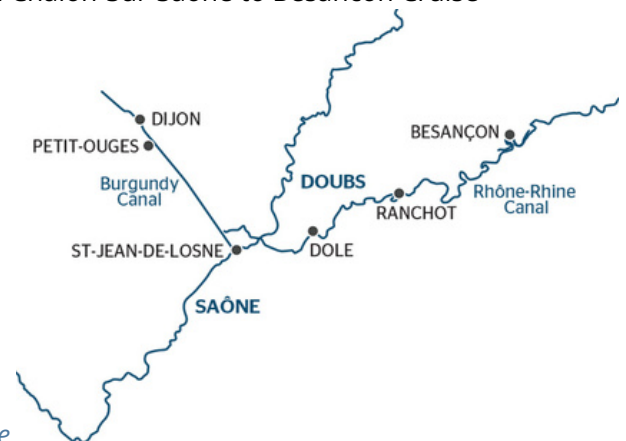

Burgundy Region Private Barge Cruise **Day by Day**

Paris pre-cruise option (see last page)

Day 1, October 20: Cruise-only guests fly to Paris.

Day 2, October 21: Hotel pre-night in Paris. Connect with Paris pre-cruise guests.

Day 3, October 22: Travel by high-speed train from Paris to Chalon-sur-saone. Embark barge around 6pm. Settle into cabins, then we'll introduce the crew at a welcome cocktail before dinner.

Day 4, October 23 - Chalon-Sur-Saone: Join us on an excursion along the Grands Crus wine route. The touristic Grands Crus wine route passes through the finest and most prestigious of the Burgundy vineyards. We'll stop along the way for a wine tasting* session.

Back to the boat. An afternoon's cruise to Seurre. This is the perfect time to fully enjoy the surrounding countryside. Arrival in Seurre in the late afternoon. This ancient, fortified town, which grew up on the banks of the Saone, has had and eventful history and still boasts a remarkable architectural heritage today.

Day 5, October 24- Seurre -Saint-Jean-De-Losne: In the morning take the 'Jaquemart trail' (1). This walk through the heart of the village invites you to discover some unusual spots. Starting from the quays, follow the Jaquemart trail. Twelve information panels describing the main building and notable sites have been installed throughout the towns streets. Follow the Jaquemart as he introduces you to Seurre's notable sites : Hotel-Dieu, Saint-Martin Church, the old bridge, the Bosset House...Two starting points are located at "Place des Marronniers' (north quay) and "Cours de Verdun' recalling Seurre's history and providing a map showing the location of al the panels.

An afternoon of cruising. This is the perfect time to fully enjoy the surrounding countryside. The banks of the Burgundy Canal are beautifully landscaped. The Greenway runs along the canal and allows you to cycle all the way along it. The is EuroVelo 6, the riverside cycle route, one of the most assessable cycle routes in France, linking Rhine to the Atlantic. Arrival in the late afternoon at Saint-Jean-de-Losne.

Day 6, October 25 Saint-John-de-Losne - Dole: Join us on a visit of Saint-Jean-de-Losne, the capital of canal barging in France, which lies at the heart of the French waterways and canal system in southern Burgundy. The afternoon will be spent cruising towards Dole.

Day 7, October 26 Ranchot - Besancon: Join us on an original and unique tour, following the "trail of Chat Perche". This trail refers to the famous tales of a Perched Cat, written by Marcel Ayme who lived in Dole as a child. It also refers to Dole's location, which is perched on a beautiful hillside. We'll return onboard and cruise towards Ranchot. you can use the bicycles (available onboard) to ride on the bike path that follows our route on the canal.

Day 8, October 27 Besancon: The morning will be spent cruising. In the afternoon, we'll set out by coach to Arc-et-Senans for a tour of the saline Royale. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this royal factory, built between 1775 and 1779 in the shape of a semi-circle, was where salt workers traditionally lived and worked, Tonight is our Gala evening.

Day 9, October 28 : Enjoy one last buffet breakfast on board before disembarking at 9:00 AM.

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
