### Bermuda: Day by Day

#### Day 1 - Tuesday, March 24 - Welcome to Bermuda

A Globe Treks representative picks you up at your door and escorts you to Charlotte Douglas Airport for your short nonstop flight to Bermuda. Upon arrival, you'll feel the island's warmth immediately — pastel cottages, blue water, and a sea breeze carrying the scent of salt and frangipani. Check in at the Grotto Bay Beach Resort and Spa, your oceanfront home for four nights. Nestled amid 21 lush acres, the resort features private pink-sand beaches, ocean-view rooms, and two remarkable natural caves filled with crystal-clear water. Enjoy a welcome cocktail reception before a leisurely dinner at the resort's waterfront restaurant.

#### Life at Grotto Bay Beach Resort

Set on a sparkling turquoise bay just minutes from St. George's, the Grotto Bay Beach and Spa captures the essence of Bermuda — elegant, unhurried, and bathed in soft ocean light. Colorful cottages with white roofs are scattered across tropical gardens, leading to private pink-sand beaches where palms sway gently in the breeze. The resort's most enchanting feature lies hidden below ground — a pair of ancient limestone caves filled with crystal-clear blue water. Guests can swim in this natural wonder or simply admire the reflections dancing on the cave walls. At day's end, enjoy cocktails on the terrace as the sky fades to coral and gold, followed by candlelit dinners overlooking the bay. Whether you choose to relax by the pool, snorkel among bright fish just offshore, or indulge in a spa treatment scented with island botanicals, Grotto Bay invites you to slow down and savor Bermuda's timeless rhythm of sea, breeze, and ease.

#### Day 2 - Wednesday, March 25 - Hamilton and the Heart of Bermuda

Every day is yours to lounge at the hotel or join us for a daily included morning excursion. After breakfast overlooking the bay, travel to Hamilton, Bermuda's colorful capital. Explore the city's flower-filled streets and elegant harbor front, lined with boutiques, galleries, and colonial buildings painted in hues of coral, mint, and yellow. Visit Cathedral of the Most Holy Trinity, stroll through the Botanical Gardens, and enjoy lunch at a waterfront café. Return to the resort for an afternoon swim, a dip in the grotto pools, or a peaceful walk along the shore before dinner.

#### Day 3 - Thursday, March 26 - Historic St. George's

This morning, explore St. George's, the oldest continuously inhabited English settlement in the New World and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stroll along narrow lanes with names like Featherbed Alley and Old Maid's Lane, and visit St. Peter's Church, built in 1612. Learn about Bermuda's early settlers and British colonial history, then enjoy free time to browse artisan shops or enjoy tea or lunch in a local café. Return to Grotto Bay for an afternoon at leisure or get out on the water and enjoy a glass-bottom boat cruise. There is no more comfortable way to see the island's underwater world, including coral reefs, sea life, and shipwrecks, through large glass panels in the boat's floor. Explore a shipwreck, witness marine life and seagrass beds where sea turtles can often be spotted.

#### Day 4 - Friday, March 27 - Somerset Village and Island Leisure

After breakfast, travel across the island to the peaceful community of Somerset Village, known for its pastel cottages, quiet charm, and the world's smallest drawbridge. Continue to Gibb's Hill Lighthouse, where 185 spiraling steps lead to breathtaking island views. The afternoon is yours to enjoy optional activities on your own or to lounge by the pool or enjoy an elegant tea at a historic manor. Tonight, celebrate your final evening in Bermuda with a festive farewell dinner.

#### Day 5 - Saturday, March 28 - Homeward Bound

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast before transferring to the airport for your return flight to Charlotte. A Globe Treks representative will return you to your doorstep, carrying home relaxing memories of pink sands, sea breezes, and Bermuda's graceful blend of British charm and island serenity.

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
