Continue to Cape Breton Island and the cozy Inverary Inn in Baddeck, your gateway to the breathtaking Cabot Trail. Wrap up your journey in vibrant Halifax at the elegant Prince George Hotel with time to enjoy Peggy's Cove and soak in Atlantic Canada's maritime spirit.

# The Canadian Maritimes: **Day by Day**

## **Day 1: From Home to the Shores of Maine – July 27**

Your journey begins with Globe Treks' signature doorstep pickup and a light continental breakfast en route to Charlotte-Douglas International Airport. Flying north to Portland, Maine, the landscape shifts from rolling hills to the rugged Atlantic coast. On arrival, our private motor coach carries us through Portland's historic streets. This afternoon, enjoy a private Portland Trolley Tour through the Old Port and to Portland Head Light, followed by an early seafood dinner overlooking the harbor.

## **Day 2: Maritime Traditions & Coastal Vistas – July 28**

This morning, immerse yourself in Maine's proud seafaring legacy at the Maine Maritime Museum in Bath. Later, cruise Bath's harbor past pine-clad islands, lobster boats, and century-old lighthouses. In the afternoon, stroll the waterfront village of Boothbay Harbor, filled with boutiques and art galleries, before gathering for a classic Maine seafood dinner.

## **Day 3: Acadia's Majesty & FDR's Island Haven – July 29**

Today's journey takes us along Maine's scenic coast to Acadia National Park, where granite mountains rise dramatically from the sea. Visit Thunder Hole, where crashing waves send plumes of spray skyward, and enjoy lunch in charming Bar Harbor. Continuing east, we cross into Canada and the secluded beauty of Campobello Island, once Franklin D. Roosevelt's summer retreat. Settle in for two peaceful nights at Roosevelt Campobello International Park.

## **Day 4: Exploring Roosevelt's Retreat on Campobello Island – July 30**

Step into history at the Roosevelt Cottage, an elegant yet unpretentious home filled with memories of FDR's summers by the sea. Stroll gardens, wander coastal trails, and take in sweeping ocean vistas where eagles soar and waves break against rocky coves. In the afternoon, enjoy tea in Eleanor Roosevelt's style at the Wells-Shober Cottage. Tonight, feast on a lobster dinner, Campobello style.

## **Day 5: The Mysteries of Fundy's Tides & Moncton's Reversing Rapids – July 31**

Departing Campobello by ferry, we enter New Brunswick, home to the Bay of Fundy, where tides rise and fall more than 40 feet — the highest in the world. Witness this natural marvel at Moncton's Reversing Rapids.

## **Day 6: Hopewell Rocks & Prince Edward Island's Coastal Charms – August 1**

At Hopewell Rocks Provincial Park, stroll among sandstone "flowerpot" formations carved by centuries of tidal motion. As the day unfolds, cross the graceful Confederation Bridge to Prince Edward Island. Settle into the elegant Holman Grand Hotel in Charlottetown.

## **Day 7: The Many Hues of Prince Edward Island – August 2**

Explore the storybook landscapes of Prince Edward Island, from the pastoral fields that inspired Anne of Green Gables to its colorful fishing villages and red-sand beaches. Visit the historic Green Gables House, then follow scenic coastal drives past dunes and harbors where fishing boats sway on the tide. Enjoy a sunset cruise and a harbor side dinner.

## **Day 8: En Route to Nova Scotia's Lakeside Splendor – August 3**

Crossing into Nova Scotia, we journey to Baddeck, a tranquil village on the shores of Bras d'Or Lake. Visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum, where the life and inventions of this visionary come to life. Tonight, relax for two nights at the charming Inverary Resort.

## **Day 9: The Legendary Cabot Trail – August 4**

With a local guide, we'll trace dramatic highland ridges and deep valleys, pausing at scenic overlooks and fishing hamlets perched above the Atlantic. The shifting light paints the cliffs in shades of emerald and sapphire—a photographer's dream. Tonight, we dine on fresh Nova Scotia seafood and lobster in celebration of this magnificent day.

## **Day 10: Halifax – A Blend of History and Modern Spirit – August 5**

Travel south to Halifax, a city that blends maritime tradition with vibrant urban life. Explore its historic waterfront, the Citadel Fortress, and lively downtown districts where old meets new. Check into the refined Prince George Hotel, ideally located for exploring the harbor front's shops and cafes. The evening is free to sample Halifax's acclaimed restaurants and music-filled pubs.

## **Day 11: Peggy's Cove and Farewell to the Coast – August 6**

A morning drive brings us to Peggy's Cove, a picturesque fishing village where colorful cottages cling to granite ledges and waves crash below its world-famous lighthouse. Capture the view, browse local artisan studios, or simply breathe in the sea air. Returning to Halifax, enjoy leisure time before our farewell dinner, a fitting finale to a journey rich in beauty, friendship, and discovery.

## **Day 12: Departure and Fond Farewells – August 7**

This morning, we bid farewell to Canada's Atlantic coast, flying home from Halifax to Charlotte.
