Since the early 1800s, Tallulah Gorge has captivated travelers. Its popularity peaked in the late 19th century following the 1882 arrival of the Tallulah Falls Railway, which brought crowds to witness grand hotels and daring spectacles, including historic tightrope walks by Professor Bachman and Karl Wallenda.

After exploring the gorge, your journey continues in the nearby Sautee Nacoochee Valley at the Folk Pottery Museum of Northeast Georgia. Housed in a striking, kiln-inspired building, this museum celebrates 200 years of regional artistry, including face jugs. Finally, head into the charming Alpine village of Helen for a traditional German lunch, local wine, and a stroll through its unique shops.
