Day 1 – A Luxurious Journey Begins

Your adventure through the Southern Appalachians begins as a Globe Treks representative greets you at your doorstep. Relax aboard our custom-designed motorcoach, where a light continental breakfast is served as you meet your fellow travelers. Our first stop is Tamarack: The Best of West Virginia, a celebrated artisan marketplace showcasing regional craftsmanship. Next, explore the Beckley Exhibition Coal Mine, where retired miners guide you on a fascinating underground rail journey through West Virginia's coal heritage. As evening approaches, enjoy Happy Hour onboard the motorcoach before arriving at the Greenbrier Resort, nestled in the Allegheny Mountains. Life at The Greenbrier

For nearly 250 years, The Greenbrier has been a symbol of Southern hospitality and refined leisure.
