Explore the picturesque Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park before taking a ferry to Roosevelt-Campobello International Park for a stay at the iconic National Park Lodge. Discover New Brunswick's highlights, including the dramatic Bay of Fundy, Reversing Falls, and Hopewell Rocks. Cross to Prince Edward Island for two nights at the Holman Grand Hotel, and then continue to Cape Breton Island, where you'll enjoy the breathtaking views along the Cabot Trail from the Inverary Inn in Baddeck. Relish fresh lobster and seafood, and soak in the charm of Halifax and Peggy's Cove. As you fly home from Halifax, you'll take with you unforgettable memories of this enchanting maritime journey.

Canadian Maritimes Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1: From Home to the Shores of Maine

A Globe Treks representative greets you at your doorstep for a seamless transfer to Charlotte-Douglas International Airport. After a continental breakfast, board your flight to Portland, Maine. A deluxe motorcoach will take you through Portland's historic districts, then to your hotel near the picturesque Boothbay Harbor, where you will spend the next two nights.

Day 2: Maritime Traditions & Coastal Vistas

Visit the Maine Maritime Museum along the Kennebec River to learn about New England's shipbuilding history. Enjoy a harbor cruise in Bath, then explore the shops and streets of Boothbay Harbor. Savor a dinner featuring Maine lobster and clams.

Day 3: Acadia National Park & FDR's Island Haven

Travel to Acadia National Park, known for its granite peaks and rugged coastlines. Stop at Thunder Hole and enjoy lunch in Bar Harbor before heading to Campobello Island for a two-night stay at a rustic lodge.

Day 4: Roosevelt-Campobello International Park

Tour Roosevelt-Campobello International Park, visiting Roosevelt Cottage, beautiful gardens, and coastal trails. Enjoy a traditional lobster dinner in the evening.

Day 5: Fundy's Tides & Moncton's Reversing Rapids

Ferry to New Brunswick to visit the Bay of Fundy, home to the world's highest tides. Witness the Reversing Rapids in Moncton before continuing to Prince Edward Island.

Day 6: Hopewell Rocks & Prince Edward Island

See the "flowerpot rocks" at Hopewell Rocks, then cross the Confederation Bridge to Prince Edward Island. Spend the night at The Holman Grand Hotel in Charlottetown.

Day 7: The Colors of Prince Edward Island

Explore Prince Edward Island, visiting Green Gables House and the island's picturesque villages. In the evening, enjoy a seafood dinner featuring mussels and lobster.

Day 8: Nova Scotia's Lakeside Splendor

Travel to Nova Scotia's Baddeck, known for its lakeside views. Visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum and stay two nights at the historic Inverary Inn.

Day 9: The Legendary Cabot Trail

Drive the Cabot Trail, famed for its dramatic cliffs and coastal views. Enjoy fresh seafood along the way.

Day 10: Halifax – History and Modern Spirit

Arrive in Halifax and explore the waterfront, the Halifax Citadel, and the Canadian Museum of Immigration. Experience the city's lively food scene at dinner.

Day 11: Peggy's Cove & Farewell

Visit the iconic Peggy's Cove lighthouse, then return to Halifax for a final day of exploration and shopping. Celebrate the journey with a farewell dinner.
